

## **FAQ related to QUARANTINE Facility for Students in IISc**

*05 June 2020*

*When you come, you will be given a Welcome kit with masks and sanitizer and an advisory sheet.*

Q. Where will we be quarantined? The hostels have shared washrooms and other shared facilities. How will the quarantine be really effective?

**Ans: You will be quarantined in your hostel rooms. This is the concept of home quarantine where all the inmates share the common places. You are also in-home quarantine and not in Institutional quarantine. We have increased the frequency of restroom sanitization, almost every 2 hours. We are also looking for extra human resources to get the sanitization done in the night after 6.00 PM.**

Q. How do we manage our meals? Will it be served in the room or will we be joining other students in the mess?

**Ans: You will be bringing your tiffin boxes and will carry your food to your room and eat . We are separating out the mess for the one who are going to undergo quarantine and the one who are there with us from Day 1 after LD.**

Q. As you know, that our hostel rooms were locked up for more than 2 months now. How can we just go and resume our stay there. Are people (Cleaning Staff etc) assigned to help us in the transition?

**Ans: As you are all re-entering the hostel, you need to do the cleaning yourself as you can very well understand that we cannot put the housekeeping staff at risk. After 14-days of your quarantine, all cleaning help will be given.**

Q. If a student develops symptoms of COVID-19 during the 14 days quarantine period or afterward, how will (s)he be treated?

**Ans:Health centre doctor will advise according and will take due care**

Q. In case of unfortunate incidence of us getting COVID, will the students insurance or the institute foot the resulting expenses?

**Ans: Student's insurance has been talked about and is in place. Dr. Satish Rao and HC doctor's team is there for all the health-related problem.**

Q. In case of any complications related to the disease, which hospital will the student be transferred to?

**Ans:There are hospitals which the doctors have identified and everything will be done only under the supervision of doctors**

Q. Will the institute take responsibility of treatment and taking care of the student? Who will be in charge of co-coordinating with hospital regularly and contacting his/her family?

Q. Keeping the 14 days' home quarantine rule on arrival of GoK in mind, how will the family be able to reach the student in case of an emergency? Will the institute allow the parents to stay inside the campus in that case? What would be the procedure for that?

**Ans: If such cases arise that parents need to be there, then parents can come and stay in the student guest house.**

Q. People from different risk zones will be landing in IISc around the same time? How are you planning to segregate them?

**Ans- As per the GOK and GoI guidelines, only students from Maharashtra are not allowed. All the rest have almost equal chances of carrying the virus**

**Need to do self-reporting for these 15 days. We will give you a recording sheet where you will record your temp and SpO2. Please carry a thermometer (essential) and pulse-oximeter (reocmmended) with you**
